ATMA DAFEC

ATMA Digital and Financial Empowerment Centre (DAFEC) conducted an expert discussion on the topic, “Financial Frauds-Kerala Model” on 11 th February 2023. The programme, held at Press club Hall, Thrissur was inaugurated by Smt Radhika, President, Press Club, Thrissur and presided over by Sri C K Suresh, Director, ATMA Foundation.



The discussions were led by Dr. M. Mohandas (Former Dean, Kerala Agriculture University), Prof. Dr. V K Vijayakumar (Expert Economist) Mr. Feesto.T.D (Sub Inspector- Kerala Police & Cyber Cell Officer), Adv. A .D. Benny (Chairman, Consumer Protection Committee) and Mr.David Kannanaikal (President, All India Chitti Foreman's Association).

The discussions gave the audience a deep insight into the various types of financial frauds that are commonly taking place now, and the precautions that the common man can adopt to avoid falling into these traps.

Eleven training programmes on Financial and Digital Literacy were conducted in February 2023 in different wards of Cherpu and Chavakkad Block Panchayaths.

As a part of SPC activity, classes on Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act were conducted at Pallissery Mahila Samajam Anganwadi centre and Harisree Anganwadi centre, both in Avinissery Panchayath. Over 160 women attended these sessions.
