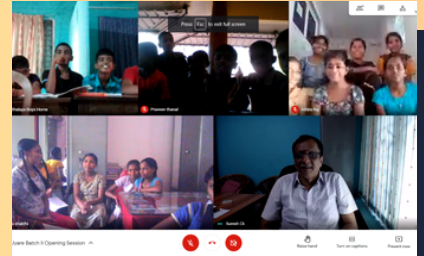

4 more Children's Homes have joined the Uyare project. We have now 11 institutions and 130 children attending our regular classes!



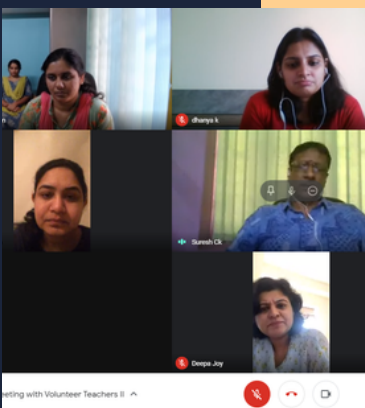
A new guest @ ATMA Gurukulam!

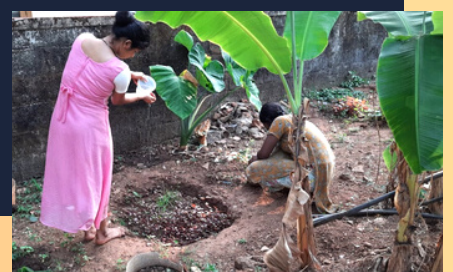
ATMA Online IELTS training commenced for the first batch of 6 nurses, guided by Smt Sujatha Nair.
